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The Solutions Group of Companies operates within the electro-mechanical repair sector, and also supply related/industry product and consumables. We also manufacture and supply Howells Stanway pumps and similar items. Management have responsibility for ensuring that the environmental policy is understood, implemented and complied with, and objectives and targets are set, monitored and reviewed. The management team provide leadership to create and maintain an environment to enable the achievement of objectives.

We recognise that our day to day activities will inevitably impact upon the environment, but must ensure that we prevent pollution from our processes. As an organisation, we must comply with all relevant environmental legislation and other requirements, and maintain a legislative register.
